

10 WORKING AT HEIGHT



Working at height outside a protected area requires the use of approved fall protection equipment secured to an approved anchor point. Other considerations include - ladders, work over water, rope access, floor openings, access hatches, and inspection pits. Floor openings should be protected with physical barriers to prevent falls. Preventing objects from falling from height and using physical barriers below working area keeps you and people working below you safe. Scaffolds should be properly constructed, inspected and certified.

- I inspect my fall protection equipment before use.
- I secure tools and work materials to prevent dropped objects.
- I tie off 100% to approved anchor points while outside a protected area.
